Making a career change is a big step and we are here to facilitate the process. There are a few pre-requisites that need to be met before starting your CDL course training. If you have done some of these already, just follow the step-by-step process and pick up where you need to finish off to start your courses with us.

**Step 1:** To receive a CDL, you must pass a written knowledge test. A copy of the CDL handbook can be obtained at; <https://www.flhsmv.gov/driver-licenses-id-cards/commercial-motor-vehicle-drivers>. Additional practice test at; <https://www.passthcdltest.com/>. This manual will help you pass the tests; however, it is not a substitute for a truck driver training class or program. Formal training is the most reliable way to learn the many special skills required for safely driving a large commercial vehicle and becoming a professional driver in the trucking industry. The material that needs to be studied is as follows:

**Class A:** To Operate truck combinations weighing 26,001 lbs. or more and towing a vehicle/unit over 10,000 lbs. a Class A License is required. The following tests are required:

-  General Knowledge
-  Combination Vehicles
-  Air Brakes

**Class B:** To operate straight trucks and buses of 26,001 lbs. or more, a Class B license is required. The following tests are required:

-  General Knowledge
-  Air Brakes Test (if applicable)
-  Passenger or desired Endorsement

**Step 2:** Contact your local DMV and schedule an appointment to take the CDL knowledge exam based on the sections you studied to receive your CDL permit.

**Step 3:** Have you taken your Drug and Alcohol Physical Exam with a medical examiner? We can refer you to our D.O.T. Physician where you can schedule an appointment:

**Step 4:** Once steps 1 to 3 are completed, stop by the school to fill out the Enrollment Agreement Form.

**Step 5:** If approved for a grant through Career Source, they will send us your approval information to start the registration process. At this point, you can visit our location to fill out the registration in paper form or go online to do the online registration.
